a biography

George graduated from the Royal College of Art with an MA in Filmmaking and several award-winning shorts. He went on to direct various ITV and BBC comedy and drama shows, and co-wrote and directed two feature films, including the critically acclaimed THE TRUTH starring Academy Award nominee Elizabeth McGovern.

He won Best UK Short at Raindance Film Festival for INFIDEL, the first in a triptych of short films, Sins of London. Most recently he has won multiple awards for another short A BULLET WASTED for Directors UK/ ARRI 'Challenge Trinity' award, shot by Oscar-nominated DoP Robbie Ryan, a story told in one 9 minute uninterrupted take.

George is hugely experienced working in content, brand and corporate, either as a director or as writer/director.

He's created work for a huge range of clients, including Accenture, AstraZeneca, Aviva, Barclays, British Gas, BT, Centrica, Coutts, De Beers, HSBC, Lloyds-TSB, McDonalds, Peroni, PwC, SAB Miller, Saudi Aramco, Sainsburys, Shell, Syngenta, RBS, and Tesco in the private sector, and British Heart Foundation, Cancer Research UK, Guide Dogs, HMRC, National Blood Service, National Trust, World Vision and many others in the public & charity sector.

Whatever brief or challenge he is set, he is interested in harnessing the enormous power of filmmaking to create compelling and emotional stories. His creative versatility has meant he has worked across all genres, including animation, to tell those stories.

He has won over 30 major international prizes for his content/corporate work: including a Black Dolphin at Cannes, an EVCOM/IVCA Gold and Silver for Best Director, and a Silver for Best Script; and a NY Festivals Gold for Best Direction.
