Most recently, I directed the 90' documentary 'MY WIFE, MY ABUSER' with Atticus Film & Television for Channel 5 and ITV Global about the twenty years of domestic abuse suffered by Richard Spencer at the hands of his wife, Sheree. Made with the support of Humberside Police, the film was picked up by Netflix where it was the No.1 show in the UK for four weeks (Oct-Nov 2024). 'My Wife, My Abuser' has been shortlisted for Best Documentary at the BROADCAST Awards, 2025 and nominated for the Best Single Documentary BAFTA.

In 2022 I directed the 90' documentary 'WHO KILLED BILLIE-JO' (Atticus Film & Television / C5 / Paramount+). The film was critic's choice in The Independent, Daily Mail, The Guardian, Daily Express, The Mirror and Daily Record. It won Best Documentary Series at the inaugural True Crime Awards, 2023. The Radio Times said: "When True Crime is this well crafted, compellingly paced, sensitive rather than sensationalist, it makes for fascinating viewing."
