CHÓRORO A feature film: Marta, a mediator for children adoption and orphan Marko form a tumultuous emotional relationship and flee from the general cruelty caused by the institutionalised inhumanity of the adoption process. (Attached as director, currently in development, with Film Center Serbia funding.)

ELVIRA A feature film for children: 12-year old Elvira, champion gamer and hacker with a police record is kidnapped, then becomes an eco-warrior on a dangerous and mystical mission.

FAST-FORWARD REWIND A triptych anthology series: a time-travel story set in a modern urban environment. In the near furure a time-travel agency takes clients into their own troubling past.

BLACK WIND (CRN VETAR) (8x50min) A British Interpol officer gets tangled in a murder case involving political corruption, set against a backdrop of witchcraft in the time-forgotten settlements in eastern Serbia.
