


# BRETT SULLIVAN DIRECTOR



















### **BRETT SULLIVAN**

### DIRECTOR

#### Background

Brett Sullivan is a London based Australian filmmaker. Born in Sydney, Australia, Brett completed school at Epping Boys High School where he topped the state in his Art results. Brett's art major work garnered national press (Sydney Morning Herald, The Australian) and TV attention (ABC, SBS) being the first Art major work to feature computer animation. He won Most Innovative Student Film of 1988 Award at the prestigious ATOM Awards.

Brett was one of the early adopters of computer graphics and quickly became a writer and lecturer on the subject. At age 18 he wrote a book, 'Desktop Video', for Federal Publishing in Australia, and was a contributing writer to the national newspaper The Australian, and various computer magazines. Whilst completing his own Bachelor of Communications, Brett also lectured at Sydney University, New South Wales University, University of Western Sydney, University of Technology, and gave lectures for the Department of Education throughout New South Wales and Queensland. He taught the first computer animation courses at the prestigious Australian Film Television and Radio School.

#### Steam Motion and Sound

Brett started production company *Woolly Mammoth* in 1995. Initially founded as a recording studio, it expanded into post production to become one of the first studios to utilize computer based video editing. Woolly Mammoth rebranded to become *Steam Motion and Sound*, a successful Sydney digital agency.

In 2000 Brett co-founded *Adstream*, which revolutionized the delivery of advertising content for television broadcasters and advertising agencies. It was the first in Australia, UK and Europe to deliver advertising content digitally, instead of videotape. Now based in 20 international offices, Adstream services global brands and agencies internationally delivering over five million advertising assets a year.

In 2005 Brett returned his focus to creative endeavours and expanded Steam to London. He relocated to the UK as Creative Director of Steam to create commercials, content, music videos and concert films for the music and theatre industries. In 2014 Steam opened an office in New York City.

Steam has found a niche in music and theatre. Subsequently, Brett has redefined the filming and editing of live stage shows. His work across the West End and Broadway for the world's biggest producers and productions has challenged conventional coverage and brought these shows to the big screen, and home entertainment, in a way unlike any other director. He has been trusted by some of the world's best film directors - Baz Lurhman, Stephen Daldry, and Sam Mendes - to direct filmed versions of their stage productions. The recent live film of Cameron Mackintosh's *Miss Saigon* was described by the Daily Mail's influential Baz Bamigboye as 'the best film of a live show I've ever seen'. Brett's cinematic approach has topped the UK box office for live event cinema with *Miss Saigon* and *Billy Elliot Live* holding the top two positions. He recently completed *Newsies Live* for Disney which will be released in cinemas February 2017.

#### Music

Brett has a passionate history in music, playing, recording and touring in bands since school. In 2016 he combined his music and stage experience by writing his first musical. *The Last Word* was nominated for the prestigious S&S Award in the UK for new musical work. Later that year a full version of the show was produced as part of the New York Music Festival showcasing new work.

Brett is a member of the DGA and has an O1 US working visa. He lives in South London with his wife Fiona, and four children, Ruby, Savannah, Jack and Rory. His house looks like it's been permanently robbed. Outside of home Brett is happy tuning the carbs on his 1972 Datsun.


