

# MARY MCGUCKIAN BIOGRAPHY

Born and brought up in Northern Ireland, Mary McGuckian began her writing/directing career in theatre in Ireland and the UK where atthe age of 25, four of her early plays had been produced including her long-running theatrical adaptation of **The Midnight Court**, which she also directed.

Continuing in the genre of literary adaptation, she directed her first screenplay WB Yeats's **Words Upon the Window Pane** and it premiered at the Venice and Sundance Film Festivals in 1994/5.

In 1995/6 she directed **This is the Sea**, adapted from her own Northern Irish 'coming of age' play **Hazel** and began work on her adaptation of **The Bridge of San Luis Rey** adapted from Thornton Wilder's Pulitzer prize winning novel which she originally directed in 2003 with Robert DeNiro, Harvey Keitel, Kathy Bates, F Murray Abraham and Gabriel Byrne. She has just completed a remaster of the project at Windmill Lane Pictures due to be released in the US in early 2022.

Auteur of over a dozen independent feature films since, she has a collaborative approach when working with actors, including more recently Aja Naomi King and Barkhad Abdi in A Girl from Mogadishu (2019) and Orla Brady, Alanis Morrissette, Vincent Perez and Dominique Pinon in The Price of Desire (2015). Her adaptation of Patrice Le Conte's Man on the Train (2011) starred Donald Sutherland and Larry Mullen Jr. Earlier films including The Amorality Trilogy Plus One (2006-2010), consisting of four films, Rag Tale, Intervention, Inconceivable and The Making of Plus One featured an international ensemble cast including Lothaire Bluteau, Donna D'Errico, Colm Feore, Rupert Graves, Ian Hart, Jennifer Jason Leigh, Jordi Molla, Andie MacDowell, Bill Patterson, Amanda Plummer, Jennifer Tilly, John Sessions, and Sarah Stockbridge amongst many others.

Actors who have worked with her have earned many best actor/actress awards and her films have picked up numerous best picture awards. She is a past recipient of the Annual Achievement Award at the WIFT Awards in Los Angeles and was one of three Irish writers selected by Screen Skills Ireland to participate in its Studio Showrunners Mentorship program in Los Angeles in 2019.

Her films have been presented at many film festivals around the world including Tribeca and Sundance in the US, Locarno and Venice in Europe and Edinburgh, London and Galway at home. Most recently, her latest film **A Girl from Mogadishu** has picked up a number of film festival audience and jury awards and was the recipient of the prestigious Cinema for Peace Foundation Women's Empowerment Award during the Berlin Film Festival in 2020.

Currently focused on episodic content, her development slate includes **Anonymous Encounters** with Danny Rose Media in the US and **#IBelieveHer**, an Irish-UK-Luxembourg co-production.
