

PERSONAL STATEMENT





My most high-profile credits are my work as Storyboard Artist for Victoria Wood on her film THAT DAY WE SANG and Specialist Research/Production Assistant on the making of documentary THAT MUSICAL WE MADE, both broadcast on BBC2. I also got my first professional credit of FILMMAKER & HEAD OF AV on the stage production of THAT DAY WE SANG that ran as part of MANCHESTER INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL in 2011.

My largest professional commission was a documentary I directed called REVEALING THE ROCH. Over 19 months I followed the uncovering of the Rochdale town centre waterway with HOPWOOD HALL COLLEGE students making up my crew. The film was commissioned by ROCHDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL in partnership with THE HERITAGE LOTTERY FUND, THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY and PRESENTS INC.

The shortest deadline I've worked to was when I had to animate a series of photographs of the River Roch bursting its banks into a timelapse clip. The animated footage was with the regional news on both BBC1 and ITV within three hours for the Rochdale Flood news item that evening.

The warmest reception a film I made received was when my documentary VARIETY OF MEMORIES was screened at the BRITISH MUSIC HALL SOCIETY's 50th Anniversary Festival at the legendary WILTON'S MUSIC HALL in London. The portrayal of the retired Variety entertainers and their life stories went over so well the film received a standing ovation.

The film that had the most exposure was probably my PRESTON PEOPLE PANORAMA short that was streamed on THE INDEPENDENT's website as part of its coverage of the PRESTON GUILD celebrations.

But the films I am proudest of are my two zero budget Art-Comedies FREELANCE GIGGLE-OH and DJANGO AWAY! I describe them as "Thingys" rather than "films" as they have taken me away from traditional film and TV production methods into an exploration of more immediate and tactile methods of manifesting my daydreams and nightmares. As well as screening these Thingys in various venues across the country, the DJANGO AWAY ORIGINAL SOUNDTRACK is available on all good streaming sites. I also wrote a book on the film's making called BETWEEN LAUGHTER & FAILURE which is available as an ebook as well as print-on-demand.

At the moment, as well as working to achieve my goal of screening FREELANCE GIGGLE-OH on every continent on Earth, I am in pre-production for another short film called THE LIE MONSTER for BLAIZE PRODUCTIONS. I am also developing scripts to land my first budgeted feature commission as well as researching for my PhD proposal.

I live in Greater Manchester with my wife and daughter and enjoy playing and coaching Basketball in my spare time. I aim to travel the world exploring different modes of film and methods of production and meet people who share my passion for the full kaleidoscope of cinema.
